

Two science classrooms at the High School, S111 and S137, have been temporarily shut down and relocated. In both cases there are active leaks in the pipes for the eyewash stations in the classrooms. There is visible mold on the wall in S137 and on the baseboard in S111.

An Industrial Hygienist inspected the classrooms today and recommended remediation of these two sections of drywall behind the eyewash stations. After remediation by a licensed environmental remediation contractor, the pipe leaks will be repaired and drywall replaced. All work will be performed at night when students and staff are not in attendance.

We expect these classrooms to be out of commission for approximately one week. Alternate student classroom assignments are being posted outside these classrooms.
