Dear Parents/Guardians,

The 2010-2011 school year is off to a great start. We currently have 2,214 students enrolled and actively engaged in the Lake Zurich High School Learning Community.

I would like to invite you to the **Lake Zurich High School Open House** on Thursday, September 2, from 7:00 – 9:10 p.m. This program will provide you with an opportunity to follow your student's schedule, meet all his/her teachers, learn about course curriculums and expectations, and visit with counselors, support personnel, and administrators. This room is located directly off the cafeteria. Our Student Database Administrator, Mrs. Marti Schak, will be there to answer any questions and, if desired, help you log on using one of the available computers to view Home Access.

Parking this year will be more limited due to May Whitney Elementary School having their Open House also. To accommodate all of the high school parents who will be attending, I would like to ask you to car pool if at all possible. We are asking parents to park in our main lower lot, in our upper lot by the Field House, and in the north lot where the staff will also park. In addition to our campus parking, additional parking will be available at the Ela Soccer Field and Worldwide Transmissions (the old Briggs building just north of the high school off Midlothian Rd.). There will be shuttle bus service from these two locations starting at 6:15 p.m. Return shuttle service will run until 9:30 p.m. Please park only in designated parking spots. **Parking is not permitted along the drive leading up to the circle entrance or any areas that are marked with yellow curbs. Cars parked in these areas will be ticketed.**
