Dear Parents:

The P.E. and Health Department at LZMSN is excited to announce a field trip! We are taking the sixth graders to the Pettit National Ice Center in Milwaukee on April 15, 2010. The \$12.00 fee will cover the cost of transportation and ice time. The KIDS ON ICE classes are taught by qualified Pettit skating school instructors. The students will learn the importance of warming up, how to start, stop, striding techniques, how to fall and get back up safely.

The Pettit National Ice Center features one of only three indoor ovals in North America. It also houses two international size (100'x 200') rinks for hockey, figure skating, short track speedskating, and enough ice to make 13 million 1"x 1" ice cubes! Imagine skating on the same ice as Olympic legends Bonnie Blair, Dan Jansen, Chris Witty, Joey Cheek, and Apolo Ohno!

SAFETY TIPS

Clothing

Dress for warmth and safety. The temperature inside the facility ranges from 50-55 degrees. Therefore, we recommend the following:
