



Homerooms to look a little different at MSN

Middle Schools are at their best when their programming supports students' growth in a variety of domains: academic, artistic, athletic, social-emotional, etc. Certainly the classroom provides many opportunities for students to develop skills with independent decision making, self-advocacy, time management, goal setting and prioritizing to name a few. However, we believe that we can do more to design students' school experience in a way that supports the core components of the District's mission: to create continuous learners, and caring, responsible citizens.

One area we are looking at is student homeroom time. Specifically, the Middle School North staff is working collaboratively on an enhanced approach to student homerooms – one that restructures the quantitative and qualitative levels of supervision that best matches students' instructional and social-emotional learning needs. What does this mean exactly?

Currently, homeroom time at MSN allows most of our students to benefit from a silent, study-hall environment where they can complete class assignments, read independently, or see teachers for assistance. During the same period, our Band, Orchestra and Chorus students benefit from daily group rehearsals. Soon, we hope to introduce and implement a Cafetorium Study Hall. This quite literally is a larger study hall that will be held in our cafeteria and supervised by faculty members. The environment will be slightly more informal than a traditional study hall, but there will remain an expectation of appropriate and productive use of time. The environment of the Cafetorium Study Hall will more closely match some students' home work/study routines. The students will exercise more control over the focus, pace and intensity of their studying, thus reflecting their ability to make responsible choices about when and how to approach their work.

Who will be eligible for the Cafetorium Study Hall? Consistent with the goal of meeting students' instructional and social-emotional needs, there will be minimum eligibility criteria, which will include students being "in good standing" with both academics and behavior. A limited number of students will be re-assigned to the Cafetorium Study Hall so as to foster a productive environment. Students in the Cafetorium will still have access to teachers, the library, the office – just the way it is now. Teachers will also retain the flexibility to direct students to different locations based on need.

Again, meeting students' individual needs is our goal, and we will regularly monitor our students' progress in order to determine the most appropriate homeroom placement. There are, of course, more details of the plan to work out, and we welcome parent and student input on the plan as we move forward with it. We will share program details through our website and we will send information home via email. In the meantime, please email Mr. Jakowitsch or Mr. Richter if you have questions, comments, or suggestions.

RACHEL'S CHALLENGE ASSEMBLY COMING TO MIDDLE SCHOOL NORTH WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 20TH

Lake Zurich Middle School North will be hosting an all school assembly called "Rachel's Challenge", Thursday, October 20th. There also will be a companion **Community Event** later that same day at 7:00 p.m. in the Middle School North Cafetorium. This evening presentation is designed for parents and adult members of the community to see and hear the same message that the middle school students were part of earlier in the day. Please come and hear this moving and inspiring presentation.

Background information about Rachel's Challenge:

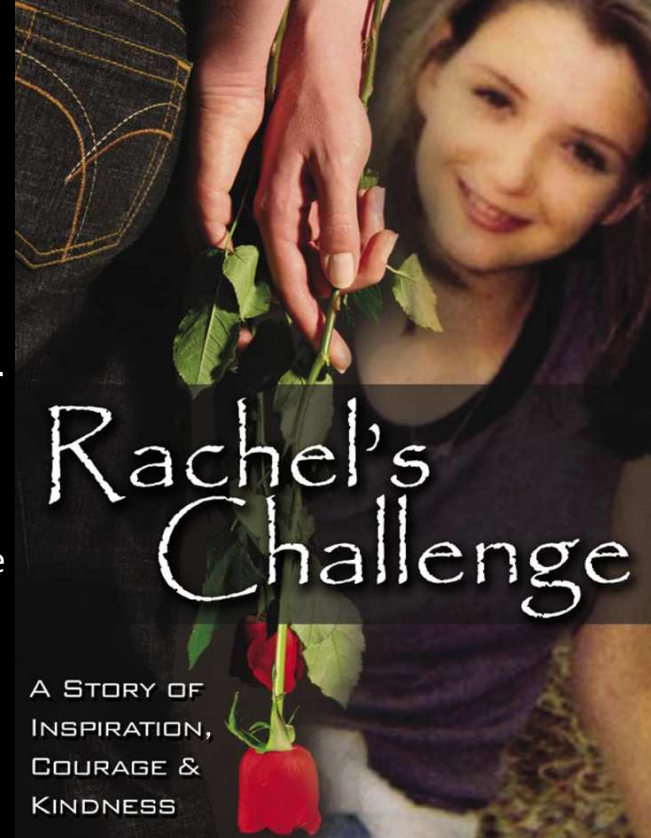
Rachel Scott was the first person killed at Columbine High School on April 20, 1999. Rachel's acts of kindness and compassion coupled with the contents of her six diaries have become the foundation for the most life-changing school program in America. Her brother, Craig, was in the library that day and lost two close friends and narrowly escape death himself. He was the only student at Columbine who was in the library, the worst of the killing zone, and also lost a sibling.

Powerful audio/video footage of Rachel's Challenge holds students spell-bound during a one-hour school presentation that motivates them to positive change in the way they treat others. In the evening presentation, the Rachel's Challenge presenter conducts a powerful session with parents and community leaders.

Scope of Effectiveness

A few weeks after the tragedy Darrell Scott, Rachel's father, spoke to a Congressional House Judiciary Committee regarding issues of school violence. His speech has become one of the most widely read on the internet. Shortly afterwards he founded "Rachel's Challenge", a bullying and violence abatement program. More than 1.5 million students annually experience Rachel's Challenge and have the opportunity to accept the challenges, modeled after Rachel's life and writings. The universal message of kindness and compassion told by Rachel's story has been heard by students in several other countries. Since its beginning in 2000, the number of requests to present Rachel's Challenge to students, parents, and educators continues to increase. The Scott family and other Rachel's Challenge certified presenters have spoken to over 15 million people in live settings, and has reached millions more through being featured on popular media outlets like CNN, Fox News, The Today Show, Good Morning America, Larry King Live, Oprah, Dateline, O'Reilly Factor, Hannity and Colmes and numerous others. Mr. Scott has also authored three books including the best seller "Rachel's Tears."



An Organization Helping District 95 Families in Need

Joanie's Closet is a service organization which originally started at May Whitney Elementary School in memory of its namesake, Joanie Bednarz, the school's longtime nurse who passed away in 2005. Two years ago, Joanie's Closet became a district-wide organization which helps families in need throughout District 95.

Joanie's Closet is available to help on several fronts. For example: school supplies are provided for families that need assistance with these items; snacks are provided for school nurses since some of those who go to see the nurse just need to fill an empty stomach; clothing, groceries, household necessities, and gas cards are distributed through the school social workers or nurses for families in dire straits; second lunches are sometimes provided at elementary schools for Free and Reduced Lunch students who are still hungry after finishing their first lunch.

With colder weather just around the corner, Joanie's Closet can also provide **winter jackets** for children who don't have one, or whose family can't afford one. We invite families to contact your school and District 95 staff to contact your Joanie's Closet rep if there is a child who needs a winter jacket, snow pants, boots, hat, and/or mittens. As always, requests and fulfillment of such requests are kept confidential.

How do I ask for help? Contact your school nurse or social worker if your family needs assistance from Joanie's Closet. Each school has a Joanie's Closet PTO representative. This representative can service requests (anonymously) from the school principal, social worker, or nurse.

How do I donate to Joanie's Closet? Joanie's Closet is always in need of financial contributions. Please consider making a personal monetary donation to Joanie's Closet; your contributions will truly help those here within our own District 95 family.

LZMSN Band & Orchestra Students Accepted into IMEA Music Festival! October 7, 2011



In early October, seventeen students from the LZMSN Band and Orchestra auditioned for the IMEA (Illinois Music Educators Association) District 7 Festival music groups.

Six students from the Symphonic Band and 11 students from Orchestra participated in the audition to perform in the IMEA Festival ensembles. Over 300 students auditioned for the Orchestra and approximately 400 auditioned for the band. Of these 700 students who auditioned, less than 300 made the cut to perform in the Festival ensembles with approximately 130 students in each ensemble. It is an incredible honor to be selected to perform with the top players in each district, as directors send the best players from each school. Middle School North is very proud to have five students participating in the Festival ensembles. Orchestra students participating include **Bokun Lee**, first violin; **Jayne Polites**, *principal* second violin; and **Angela Ketcham**, viola. **Caleb Harada** on trumpet and **Sangami Pugazenthi** on Alto Saxophone will proudly represent MSN in the IMEA District Band. 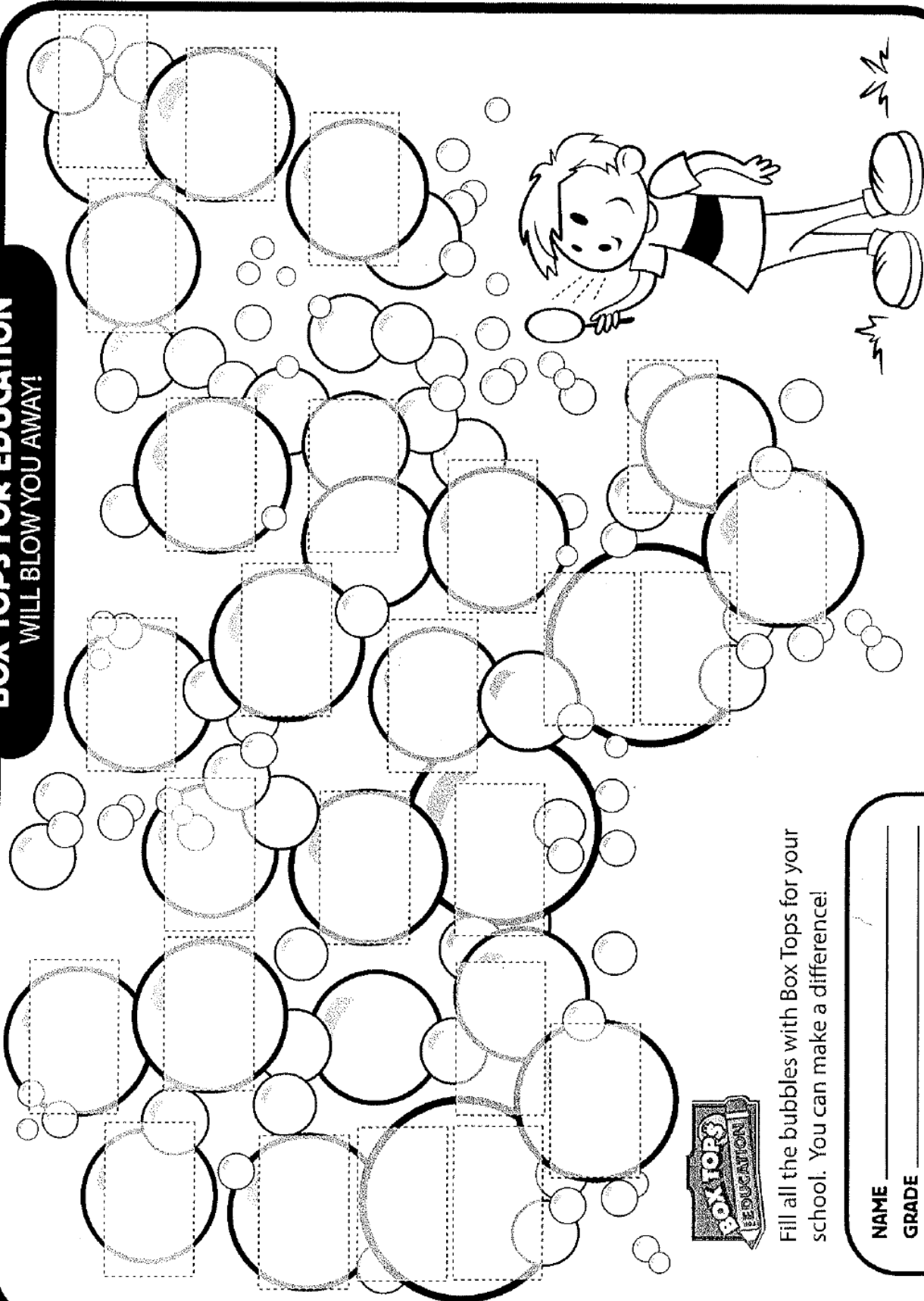
