You will need to read product labels as some products are made and/or processed in same facilities as products made with peanuts.

**This will also include any parties during school year – ie: Halloween, Valentines Day, end of school year.**

Some children with peanut allergies can become seriously ill with just coming in contact with the peanut oils.
