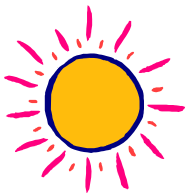
Thank you to all who placed orders this year! You helped raise \$2144.92 for Sarah Adams. Way to go!!!

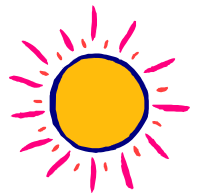
