## Summer Construction

There will be some exterior construction taking place at Spencer Loomis and Middle School North this summer. Last summer there was significant repair completed to the concrete near the entrance of both schools. There will be some additional concrete repair work done this summer beginning June 13th until July 5th. **The front circle of Middle School North and Spencer Loomis will be closed to all traffic from June 13th to July 5th.** There will also be construction and repair done to the south entrance (door #7) near the Spencer Loomis gym entrance. That area will be off limits for most of July. There will be concrete replacement and regrading of the landscaping. If you have any questions please feel free to contact me over the summer.
